ASSUNTO: **Adesão da Câmara Municipal de Setúbal à rede ICLEI – *Local Governments for Sustainability***

Atualmente, no contexto de alterações climáticas que vivemos e na necessidade de uma resposta global e concertada aos seus riscos e consequências, torna-se crescente a consciencialização para a importância que o trabalho colaborativo e em rede confere aos processos de planeamento territorial. Nos últimos anos, o Município de Setúbal tem vindo a assumir o compromisso em desenvolver este trabalho em parcerias, aumentando assim, o conhecimento nas áreas do desenvolvimento sustentável e ação climática.

A rede ICLEI – *Local Governments for Sustainability* é uma rede global que envolve cerca de 2500 governos locais e regionais empenhados no desenvolvimento urbano sustentável, promovendo e incentivando a ação e criando uma dinâmica que reforça a ambição de todos estes atores no desenvolvimento sustentável dos territórios.

Em Portugal, a rede ICLEI conta com 11 membros: Seixal, Almada, Lisboa, Oeiras, Cascais, Torres Vedras, Águeda, Valongo, Matosinhos, Guimarães e Braga.

A adesão do Município de Setúbal à rede ICLEI apresenta as seguintes vantagens:

- Descontos e acesso prioritário a eventos, conferências e workshops organizados pela rede e por parceiros;
- Organização de eventos da ICLEI no nosso Município como a EcoProcura, European Conferences on Sustainable Cities and Towns, Local Renewables, Resilient Cities e Informed Cities;
- Divulgação da atividade do Município de Setúbal uma vez que a rede ICLEI dá a conhecer projetos sustentáveis dos membros através do seu boletim informativo eletrónico mensal e dos canais das redes sociais, notícias e nas secções “Membros em Destaque” no seu site oficial;
- Acesso a publicações, casos de estudo e ferramentas de trabalho e gestão, bem como atualizações sobre os desenvolvimentos no domínio da sustentabilidade;
- Formação e materiais personalizados a preços reduzidos sobre temas como a sustentabilidade, gestão integrada da água e planos de ação para a energia sustentável;

- Os membros têm ainda condições especiais de acesso aos serviços de consultadoria e aconselhamento especializado em contratação pública sustentável, clima e energia.

O custo de adesão à rede ICLEI depende do número de habitantes do Município e do rendimento global per capita do país, assim o Município de Setúbal terá de pagar 1 750,00€ (mil setecentos e cinquenta euros) por ano para fazer parte da rede. Este valor tem cabimento na rubrica 0201/06020309.

Atento o exposto propõe-se, que a Câmara Municipal delibere:

- a) A aprovação da adesão da Câmara Municipal de Setúbal à rede ICLEI – *Local Governments for Sustainability*, conforme anexo integrante desta proposta;
- b) A designação da Dr.ª Cristina Coelho enquanto ponto focal da Câmara Municipal de Setúbal para esta rede.

Mais se propõe a aprovação, em minuta, da parte da ata referente à presente deliberação, de acordo com o disposto no n.º 3 e no n.º 4 do artigo 57.º da Lei n.º 75/2013, de 12 de setembro.

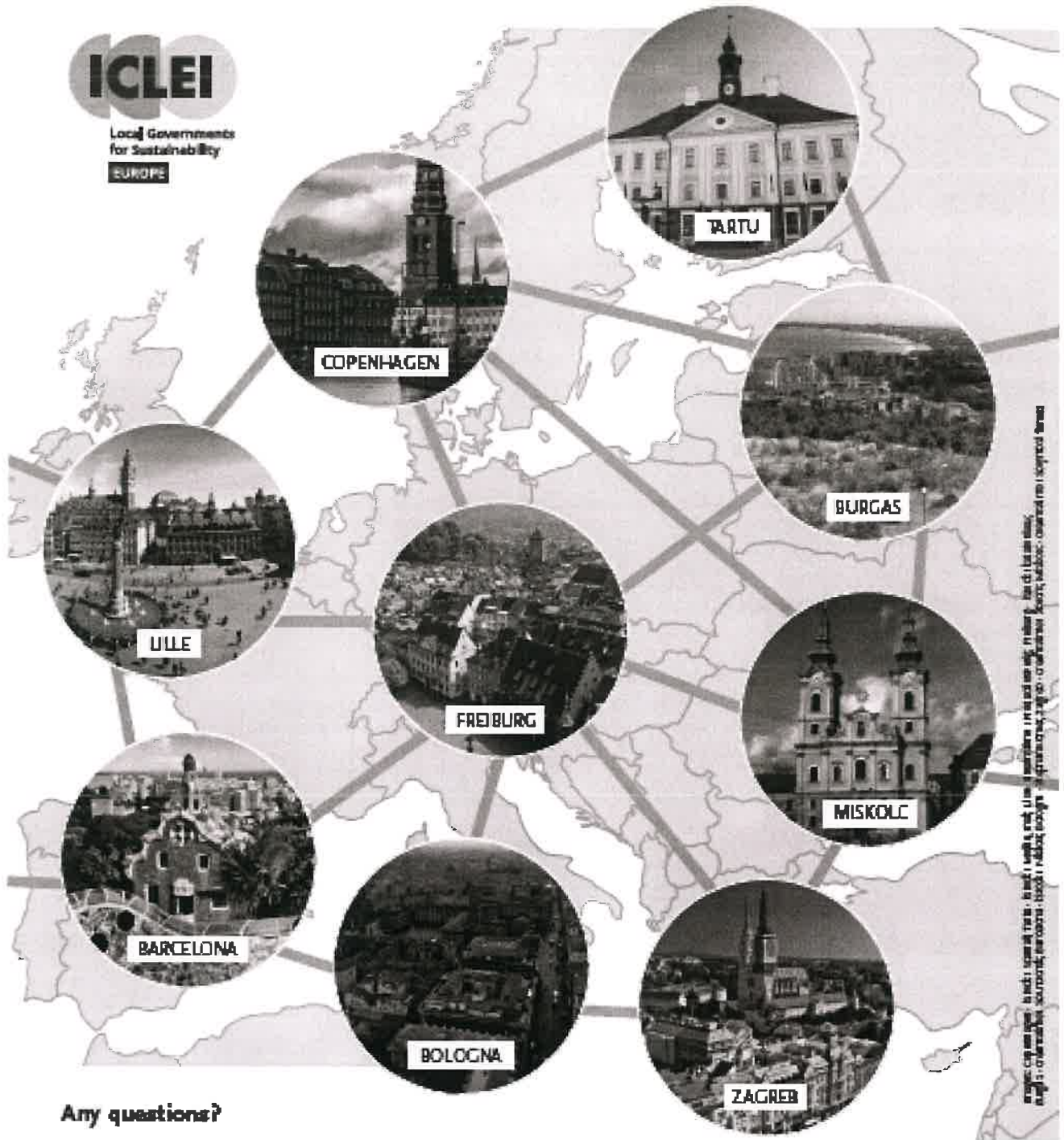

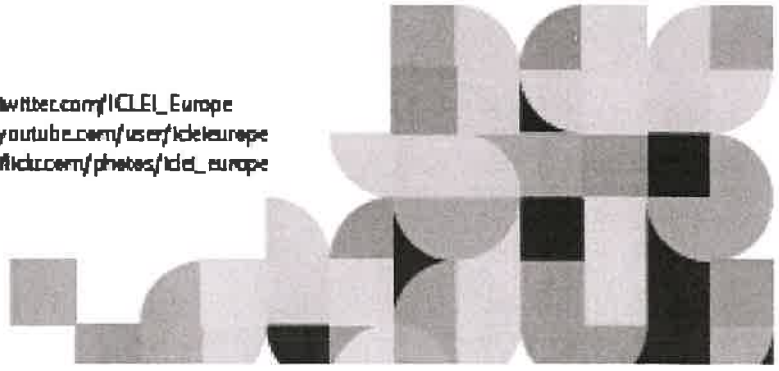
